2	To enact R.S. 32:191.1(F), relative to penalties for vehicle violations; to provide for the
3	application of certain penalties to violations of any driver or operator of a vehicle;
4	and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 32:191.1(F) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§191.1. Operating motorcycles on roadways laned for traffic
8	* * *
9	F. Penalties imposed by this Chapter shall be applicable to any driver or
10	operator of a vehicle, as defined in R.S. 32:1, who is found guilty of or pleads guilty
11	or nolo contendere to a violation of the provisions of this Chapter, including this
12	Section, or any regulation of the department, secretary, and commissioner made
13	pursuant thereto.

Abstract: Specifies that certain penalties for vehicle violations are applicable to any driver or operator of a vehicle.

<u>Present law</u> provides the provisions for operating a motorcycles on roadways and prescribes penalties for violations of these provisions.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and specifies that penalties imposed by <u>present law</u> are applicable to any driver or operator of a vehicle, as defined in <u>present law</u>, who is found guilty of or pleads guilty or nolo contendere to a violation of the provisions of <u>present law</u>, including R.S. 32:191.1, or any regulation of the department, secretary, and commissioner made pursuant thereto.
