## CRIMINAL/SENTENCING: Provides relative to sentencing provisions for crimes of violence

1	AN ACT
2	To enact Code of Criminal Procedure Article 890.4, relative to sentencing; to provide
3	relative to sentencing for crimes of violence committed in certain districts; and to
4	provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. Code of Criminal Procedure Article 890.4 is hereby enacted to read as
7	follows:
8	Art. 890.4. Sentencing for crimes of violence committed in cultural, historical, or
9	downtown development districts
10	When a defendant is sentenced for any offense defined or enumerated as a
11	crime of violence in R.S. 14:2(B) that has been committed in an area designated as
12	a state cultural district as defined in Chapter 11 of Title 25 of the Louisiana
13	Administrative Code, a historical preservation district as provided in Chapter 16 of
14	Title 25 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a historic place as listed in the
15	National Register established in 54 U.S.C. 302101 through 302108, or a downtown
16	development district as defined in Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,
17	that sentence shall be served without the benefit of parole, probation, or suspension
18	of sentence.

Abstract: Creates a new sentencing provision for crimes of violence committed in cultural, historical, or downtown development districts.

Present law (R.S. 14:2(B)) provides for offenses considered crimes of violence.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a defendant shall serve a sentence without the benefit of parole, probation, or suspension for any offense defined or enumerated as a crime of violence in <u>present law</u> that has been committed in an area designated as a cultural, historical, or downtown developmental district.
