EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS: Provides relative to the sale, transportation, and acceptance of propane and other fuels during a declared natural disaster

AN ACT

2 To enact Chapter 17-A of Title 51 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be 3 comprised of R.S. 51:1611, relative to the sale and transport of propane and other 4 fuels; to provide for the sale, transportation, and acceptance of propane and other 5 fuels to individuals in affected areas during a declared natural disaster; and to 6 provide for related matters. 7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 8 Section 1. Chapter 17-A of Title 51 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, 9 comprised of R.S. 51:1611, is hereby enacted to read as follows: 10 CHAPTER 17-A. SALE, TRANSPORTATION, AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUEL 11 §1611. Sale, transportation, and acceptance of fuel following a natural disaster 12 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, following a 13 declared natural disaster, the diversion, sale, transport, delivery, or acceptance of 14 gasoline, diesel fuel, liquified petroleum gas, motor fuel, special fuel, gasohol, 15 liquified natural gas, and other types of fuel, across jurisdictional boundaries within 16 this state shall not be restricted or prohibited when needed for disaster recovery, 17 including but not limited to supplying fuel to generators, motor vehicles, homes and other resources to provide electricity, heat, light, meals, and other necessities to 18 19 persons in affected areas.
