Provides relative to medical examinations

Proposed law provides that if any dispute arises as to the condition of the employee, the employee's capacity to work, or whether the alleged injury or disability was caused by an alleged work-related incident, the assistant secretary shall order an additional medical opinion. Proposed law provides that if both parties agree on the choice of physician to conduct the additional medical examination, the parties may present the choice to the assistant secretary and that physician shall be selected to conduct the examination. Proposed law changes present law and provides that any party wishing to request an additional medical opinion regarding a medical examination of the claimant shall make such a request prior to the pretrial mediation conference. Proposed law deletes the requirement that the medical examination report provide any future treatment the medical examiner recommends within reason
