

OFFICIAL PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE TOWN OF ADDIS, LOUISIANA

(NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INTRODUCE LOCAL BILL)

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, AS PROVIDED BY SECTION 13, ARTICLE III OF THE CONSTITUTION OF LOUISIANA, THAT THERE WILL BE INTRODUCED AT THE FORTHCOMING SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE OF LOUISIANA, TO BE CONVENED ON MARCH 14, 2022, A BILL RELATIVE TO THE TOWN OF ADDIS; TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE TOWN OF ADDIS TO PAY MEMBERS OF THE ADDIS PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION A PER DIEM; TO PROVIDE FOR THE AMOUNT OF THE PER DIEM AND THE NUMBER OF MEETINGS FOR WHICH MEMBERS MAY BE PAID; AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS.
