SECONDHAND DEALERS OR INCREASE LF EX See Note Provides with respect to the purchase of catalytic converters

<u>Proposed legislation</u> requires a seller of a catalytic converter to provide documents of origin sufficient to prove that the catalytic converter is not stolen property. Penalties include a fine of not less than \$500, imprisonment of no more than 1 year, or both.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no direct material effect on the Department of Public Safety & Corrections - Corrections Services (DPS&C) expenditures as a result of the proposed legislation. The proposed legislation is a misdemeanor; therefore, these offenders are not sentenced to DPS&C.

Local law enforcement agencies will realize an indeterminable increase in expenditures associated with prison costs to the extent a person is convicted under this statute. The cost increase will depend on the number of persons convicted, the minimum sentence an offender serves, and the cost per day for a local law enforcement agency to incarcerate an offender.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There will be an indeterminable increase in local funds revenue as a result of potential fines if a person is convicted under this statute. The minimum fine is \$500 (with no limit) and the potential revenue will accrue to the local government entities.
