Present law (R.S. 49:112) prohibits payment by the state treasurer for any claim or debt against the state if more than 10 years have lapsed from the event or facts upon which any judgment is rendered. Proposed law creates an exception for the judgment rendered in the case captioned "Jean Boudreaux and the Victims of the Flood on April 6, 1983 on the Tangipahoa River versus the State of Louisiana, Department of Transportation, et al." rendered on June 10, 2005, bearing Number 2004 CA 0985, on the docket of the Court of Appeal, First Circuit. Further appropriates \$45,000,000 out of the State General Fund (Direct) for FY 2021-2022 for payment of a portion of this judgment.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
