COURTS. Provides relative to the judgeships of the family court for East Baton Rouge Parish. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 13:1401.1 and 1403, relative to judgeships of the family court for East Baton Rouge Parish; to provide for the organization of election sections within the family court; to provide for the assignment of judgeships for election purposes; to provide for the election of judges; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

The family court for the parish of East Baton Rouge shall consist of three election sections. 8	(B) The successor to the office of a judge of the family court for the parish of East
9	Baton Rouge shall be elected from the election section assigned to that office as provided
10	by R.S. 13:1403. The election shall be from the election section composed as provided by
11	R.S. 13:1401.1.
12	Section 3.(A) The precincts referenced in this Act are those precincts identified as
13	Voting Districts (VTDs) in the 2020 Census Redistricting TIGER/Line Shapefiles for the
14	State of Louisiana as validated through the data verification program of the Louisiana House
15	of Representatives and the Louisiana Senate and available on the legislature's website on the
16	effective date of this Section.
17	(B) When a precinct referenced in this Act has been subdivided by action of the
18	parish governing authority on a nongeographic basis or subdivided by action of the parish
19	governing authority on a geographic basis in accordance with the provisions of R.S.
20	18:532.1, the enumeration in this Act of the general precinct designation shall include all
21	nongeographic and all geographic subdivisions thereof, however such subdivisions may be
22	designated.
23	(C) The territorial limits of the districts as provided in this Act shall continue in
24	effect until changed by law regardless of any subsequent change made to the precincts by
25	the parish governing authority.
26	Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
27	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
28	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become

1 effective on the day following such approval.

Fields

<u>Present law</u> provides that the family court for the parish of East Baton Rouge will consist of three election sections and provides for the boundaries of the election sections.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains the three election sections but changes the section boundaries.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the family court of East Baton Rouge Parish will be composed of four judges.

<u>Present law</u> provides that one of the judges will be elected from election section one; one of the judges will be elected from election section two; and two of the judges will be elected from election section three.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that precincts referenced in district descriptions are those precincts identified as Voting Districts (VTDs) in the 2020 Census Redistricting TIGER/Line Shapefiles for the state of La. as validated through the data verification program of the La. legislature. Also specifies that if any such precinct has been subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a nongeographic basis or subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a geographic basis in accordance with <u>present law</u>, the enumeration of the general precinct designation shall include all nongeographic and all geographic subdivisions thereof. Further provides that the territorial limits of the districts as enacted shall continue in effect without change regardless of any subsequent change made to the precincts by the parish governing authority.

Population data, statistical information, and maps are supplied for purposes of information and analysis and comprise no part of <u>proposed law</u>.


