Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary A to Original Senate Bill No. 214
by Senator Luneau

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "depositions", delete the rest of the line

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, delete lines 3 and 4, and insert the following:

5 "and trial testimony of certain insurance claims adjusters; to require certain out-of-
6 state insurance claims adjusters to appear and offer testimony; to provide for venue;
7 to provide for definitions; and to provide for related matters.

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 9, after "jurisdiction", delete the rest of the line, and insert "**;** **exceptions;**
10 **out-of-state insurance claims adjusters**"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 1, delete lines 15 through 17, and insert the following:

13 **"B.(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, an**
14 **insurance claims adjuster who is not a resident of Louisiana but who has**
15 **adjusted an insurance claim in the state which is the subject of a civil suit shall**
16 **be required to appear in person in the parish or venue in which the civil suit is**
17 **pending and to testify at a pretrial deposition or at the trial on the merits.**

18 **(2) For purposes of this Subsection, "insurance claims adjuster" shall**
19 **have the same meaning as "adjuster" as defined in R.S. 22:1661."**
