LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS. Constitutional Amendment to provide for remote operations of the legislature during a declared emergency. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

1	A JOINT RESOLUTION
2	Proposing to amend Article XII, Section 11 of the Constitution of Louisiana, relative to
3	continuity of government during periods of emergency; to provide relative to
4	sessions, meetings, and proceedings of the legislature and legislative bodies; to
5	provide relative to member participation and voting; to provide certain procedures,
6	terms, conditions, and requirements; and to specify an election for submission of the
7	proposition to electors and provide a ballot proposition.
8	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
9	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state, for
10	their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to amend Article XII,
11	Section 11 of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:
12	§11. Continuity of Government
13	Section 11. The legislature shall provide for is authorized by law and rules
14	to provide for the orderly and temporary continuity of state government, in periods
15	of emergency, until normal processes of government can be reestablished in
16	accordance with the constitution and laws of the state; and, except as otherwise
17	provided by this constitution, for the prompt and temporary succession to the powers

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1	and duties of public offices when incumbents become unavailable to perform their
2	functions. To preserve the continuity of government, remote participation and
3	voting in open, public meetings via electronic means may be authorized for
4	members of the legislature to transact business during a public emergency. No
5	measure shall be enacted or adopted by remote action unless at least a majority
6	of the elected members of either house are unable to meet in person at the state
7	capitol due to the emergency.
8	Section 2. Be it further resolved that this proposed amendment shall be submitted
9	to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on
10	November 8, 2022.
11	Section 3. Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at said election
12	there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted
13	to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as
14	follows:
15	Do you support an amendment to preserve continuity of government by
16	authorizing members of the legislature under certain circumstances to
17	remotely participate and vote in order to transact business during a public
18	emergency?
19	(Amends Const. Art. XII, Sec. 11)

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Hewitt

<u>Present constitution</u> provides that the legislature shall provide for orderly and temporary continuity of state government, in periods of emergency, until normal processes of government can be reestablished in accordance with the constitution and laws of the state; and, except as otherwise provided by <u>present constitution</u>, for the prompt and temporary succession to the powers and duties of public offices when incumbents become unavailable to perform their functions.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> retains <u>present constitutional provision</u> and adds that to preserve continuity of government, remote participation and voting in open, public meetings may be authorized for members of the legislature to transact business during a public emergency. Further provides that no measure shall be enacted or adopted by remote action unless at least a majority of the elected members of either house are unable to meet in person at the state capitol due to the emergency.

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Specifies submission of the amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held on November 8, 2022.
