3 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
4 continue the Healthcare Workplace Violence Task Force created by House Concurrent
5 Resolution No. 121 of the 2021 Regular Session.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the membership and purposes of the task force
7 shall continue as provided in House Concurrent Resolution No. 121 of the 2023 Regular
8 Session.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall submit a report of its
10 activities, findings, and recommendations to the House Committee on Health and Welfare,
11 the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare, and the David R. Poynter Legislative
12 Research Library no later than sixty days prior to the convening of the 2023 Regular Session
13 of the Legislature.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that legislative authority for the task force shall
15 terminate on July 1, 2023.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
17 secretary of the Louisiana Department of Health, the secretary of the Department of Children
18 and Family Services, the executive director of the Louisiana State Board of Nursing, the
19 executive director of the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners, the president of the
20 Louisiana State Nurses Association, the president of the Louisiana Association of Nurse
21 Practitioners, the chairman of the Louisiana Organization for Nursing Leadership, the
22 president of the Louisiana Hospital Association, the chairman of the Nursing Supply and
23 Demand Council, the executive director of the Louisiana State Medical Society, the
24 president of the Louisiana Chapter of the American Psychiatric Nurses Association, the
25 executive director of the Louisiana Chiefs of Police Association, the president of the
26 Louisiana Sheriffs' Association, and the chief justice of the Louisiana Supreme Court.
