There will be a decrease in self-generated revenue for the Department of Public Safety & Corrections - Corrections Services (DPS&C) as a result of the elimination of copayments by inmates. For illustrative purposes, DPS&C reports over the past 5 years, copayments collected from inmates for medical or dental treatment average \$169,829 annually.
