Proposed legislation requires each public school to observe "Celebrate Freedom Week" each September, in conjunction with Constitution Day and Constitution Week. Proposed legislation requires each public school governing authority to ensure that all students receive age and grade-appropriate instruction, in a social studies or other appropriate course, on topics related to freedom. Such topics may include, but are not limited to, the nation's founding and the intent, meaning and importance of the Declaration of Independence and the United States Constitution, including the Bill of Rights.
