Present law requires the Secretary of State to prepare the voting machines for the election by placing them in order, inserting the proper ballot, and testing and adjusting the machines for the election. Each machine will produce a test vote report. Proposed law requires the Secretary of State to submit the test vote report to the Parish Board of Election Supervisors for inspection and review.
