Amendments proposed by House Committee on Commerce to Original House Bill No. 240 by Representative Emerson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 1, delete lines 3 through 5 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:
- 3 "provisional license for massage therapy graduates; to require notification to a client;
- to provide for a sunset date; and to provide for related matters." 4

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, at the end of line 8, insert a semicolon ";" and "provisional licensure"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

- 8 On page 1, delete lines 13 through 15 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:
- 9 "board. The provisional license shall be active for one three-month term and shall 10 not be renewed. Any facility that employees a massage therapist who is operating 11 under a provisional license shall notify a client of the licensure status of a 12 provisionally-licensed massage therapist prior to the client receiving any services from that massage therapist.

- 14 Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall cease to be effective on December 31, 15 2025."
