R.S. 26:911.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 7 §911.1. Preemption 8 The establishment of minimum age requirements for the purchase, 9 possession, marketing, taxing, sale. or delivery of tobacco products is preempted by 10 the provisions of this Chapter, R.S. 14:91.8, and any other applicable state law.
