TOBACCO/TOBACCO PRODUCTS: Provides relative to the preemption of local ordinances regarding tobacco products

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 26:911.1, relative to tobacco products; to provide relative to regulation of
3 minimum age requirements for the purchase of tobacco products; to provide for the
4 preemption of local ordinances; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 26:911.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §911.1. Preemption

8 The establishment of minimum age requirements for the purchase,
9 possession, marketing, taxing, sale, or delivery of tobacco products is preempted by
10 the provisions of this Chapter, R.S. 14:91.8, and any other applicable state law.
