**Abstract:** Provides relative to election tabulation audits of voter-verified paper records.

Present law provides for the powers and duties of the secretary of state with respect to voting machines. Requires the secretary to promulgate uniform rules and regulations with respect to procurement, preparation, and use of voting systems. Provides that such rules and regulations shall provide for standards and procedures for the control and auditability of voter-verified paper records.

Proposed law retains present law and requires the secretary of state to establish policies and procedures for the conduct of a post-election tabulation audit of in-person and absentee by mail voter-verified paper records.
