COSMETOLOGY/BOARD: Provides relative to the membership of the La. State Board of Cosmetology

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 37:571(B) and 572(B), relative to the Louisiana State Board of
3 Cosmetology; to provide for an additional board member; to provide that one
4 member of the board shall be a licensed esthetician; and to provide for related
5 matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 37:571(B) and 572(B) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
8 follows:

9 §571. Louisiana State Board of Cosmetology; creation; domicile; membership

10 * * *

11 B. The board shall be composed of ~~eight~~ nine members appointed by the
12 governor, who shall serve at the pleasure of the governor. At least one member shall
13 be appointed from each congressional district.

15 §572. Qualifications of board members; recusal from certain transactions

17 B.(1) ~~Each member~~ Eight of the members shall each be a registered
18 cosmetologist who has been actively engaged, for at least five years prior to his
19 appointment, in the practice of cosmetology, or an owner of a beauty shop or salon

1 certified pursuant to R.S. 37:591, or as a teacher or instructor of cosmetology in this
2 state.

3 (2) One member shall be a registered esthetician who has been actively
4 engaged, for at least five years prior to his appointment, in the practice of esthetics.

HB 937 Original 2022 Regular Session Butler

Abstract: Adds one member to the La. State Board of Cosmetology.

Present law provides for eight members of the La. State Board of Cosmetology

Proposed law adds one member to the board.

Present law requires that each member be a registered cosmetologist with at least five years of experience as a cosmetologist, a salon owner, or a teacher of cosmetology prior to becoming a board member.

Proposed law requires that eight of the nine board members be subject to the requirements set forth in present law.

Proposed law requires that one member of the board be a registered esthetician with at least five years of experience in esthetics prior to becoming a board member.
