**Abstract:** Provides relative to certain required characteristics of student populations at charter schools.

Present law provides relative to the chartering, regulation, governance, and operation of charter schools.

Present law generally requires a charter school to enroll a certain number of economically disadvantaged students and to enroll a certain number of students with an exceptionality other than being gifted or talented. Specifically, a charter school is required to enroll such students so that the percentage of such students in the school is 85% of the percentage of such students in the school district or districts from which the charter school enrolls its students.

Proposed law retains present law except to provide that the populations of such students in the school shall be 85% of the populations of such students in the *parish or parishes* from which the school enrolls students, rather than of the school district or districts.
