1 A RESOLUTION

2 To recognize Wednesday, April 6, 2022, as Louisiana Chamber of Commerce Day at the
3 state capitol.

4 WHEREAS, in Louisiana, the private sector employs nearly 1.6 million people; and

5 WHEREAS, Louisiana's economy is increasingly diversified, with strong
6 representation in the manufacturing, healthcare, construction, hospitality, oil and gas,
7 educational services, finance, maritime, and transportation sectors; and

8 WHEREAS, thousands of companies and entrepreneurs in Louisiana participate in
9 local chambers of commerce, which have a mission to promote jobs, economic growth, and
10 strong communities in every region of the state; and

11 WHEREAS, Louisiana chambers of commerce are taking an active role in the
12 legislative process in Baton Rouge to amplify the voice of employers and to encourage state
13 leaders to take actions that will promote a positive business climate and support and
14 strengthen the economy of the pelican state; and

15 WHEREAS, more than fifty chambers of commerce have joined together to create
16 the Louisiana Association of Chamber of Commerce Executives to support chamber leaders
17 by providing them with information, professional development, and best practices so they
18 can better serve Louisiana employers and communities.

19 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
20 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize Wednesday, April 6, 2022, as Louisiana
21 Chamber of Commerce Day at the state capitol and does hereby express appreciation to

1 Louisiana's chambers of commerce, which seek to expand opportunities for the state's
2 citizens and make Louisiana a great place to live and work.

4 president of the Louisiana Association of Chamber of Commerce Executives.
