**Abstract:** Provides for bad faith liability for the Louisiana Insurance Guaranty Association.

<u>Present law</u> provides that any insurer who breaches its good faith duties shall be liable for any damages sustained as a result of the breach.

<u>Present law</u> provides that in addition to any general or special damages to which a claimant is entitled for breach of the imposed duty, the claimant may be awarded penalties assessed against the insurer in an amount not to exceed 2 times the damages sustained or \$5,000, whichever is greater.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the Insurance Guaranty Association Fund (IGAF), as provided in <u>present law</u> (R.S. 22:2051 et seq.), shall not be liable for any special damages awarded under the provisions of <u>present law</u>. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals this exemption from liability.
