11	E.(1) Any website or domain name with any of the following meta tags			
12	shall verify that each user accessing the contents on its website or under its			
13	domain name is at least eighteen years of age or older:

15	(b) <meta content="adult" name="rating"/> .			
16	(c) <meta content="mature" name="rating"/> .			
17	(d) <meta content="restricted" name="rating"/> .

1	(2) The website or domain name shall verify the user's identity and age
2	by using a product or service that can digitally identify the user's name and
3	identity immediately upon accessing the website or domain name. The product
4	or service that is provided shall be at the cost of the website or domain name.
5	$\mathbf{F}$ . Any violation of this Section shall be an unfair trade practice and shall
6	subject the violator to any and all actions and penalties provided for in this Chapter.

<u>Present law</u> provides relative to internet safety for children and requires an internet service provider to make available to an internet subscriber a product or service that enables the subscriber to control a child's use of the internet. A violation of <u>present law</u> shall be an unfair trade practice and subject the violator to all actions and penalties prescribed in the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides that a website or domain name with an adult, mature, and restrictive meta tag, shall verify that all users are at least 18 years old or older.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the website or domain name shall provide a way for users to digitally provide identification immediately upon accessing its website or domain name at the cost of the website or domain name.

Effective August 1, 2022.
