1AN ACT

2To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1856.1(A), relative to pharmacy record audits; to clarify the

3definition of a pharmacy benefit manager; and to provide for related matters.

4Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5Section 1. R.S. 22:1856.1(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

6§1856.1. Pharmacy record audits; recoupment; appeals

7A. As used in this Section, "entity" means a managed care company,

8insurance company, third-party payor, or the representative of the managed care

9company including a pharmacy benefit manager as defined in R.S. 22:1641,

10insurance company, or third-party payor.

**Abstract:** Clarifies the definition of a "pharmacy benefit manager" relative to pharmacy record audits.

Present law (R.S. 22:1856.1(A)) defines an "entity" with respect to pharmacy record audits. "Entity" includes a pharmacy benefit manager. Proposed law retains present law but clarifies that a pharmacy benefit manager means the same as the term is defined in present law (R.S. 22:1641).
