7	A. As used in this Section, "entity" means a managed care company			
8	insurance company, third-party payor, or the representative of the managed care			
9	company including a pharmacy benefit manager as defined in R.S. 22:1641,

Abstract: Clarifies the definition of a "pharmacy benefit manager" relative to pharmacy record audits.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 22:1856.1(A)) defines an "entity" with respect to pharmacy record audits. "Entity" includes a pharmacy benefit manager. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but clarifies that a pharmacy benefit manager means the same as the term is defined in <u>present law</u> (R.S. 22:1641).
