STATE EMPLOYEES: Provides relative to the minimum wage of state employees

1	AN ACT		
2	To enact Chapter 10 of Title 42 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of		
3	R.S. 42:541 through 545, relative to compensation of state employees; to establish		
4	a minimum wage for state employees; to provide for civil remedies and recovery of		
5	damages; and to provide for related matters.		
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:		
7	Section 1. Chapter 10 of Title 42 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,		
8	comprised of R.S. 42:541 through 545, is hereby enacted to read as follows:		
9	CHAPTER 10. MINIMUM WAGE		
10	§541. Minimum wage; established		
11	A. Except as otherwise provided by this Chapter, no state employee shall be		
12	paid at a rate of less than nine dollars per hour. This minimum rate applies		
13	regardless of how the time at work is measured.		
14	B. If federal or state law requires a minimum rate of pay for a state employee		
15	that is higher than the rate required by this Section, the law requiring the higher rate		
16	shall apply to compensation of the employee.		
17	<u>§542. Civil remedy</u>		
18	A. In addition to any other remedy provided by law, an employee shall have		
19	a civil right of action for damages against an employer for a violation of the		
20	provisions of R.S. 42:541.

1	B. Venue for such a civil action shall be proper in the Nineteenth Judicial
2	District Court in East Baton Rouge Parish.
3	§543. Damages
4	An employer that violates the provisions of R.S. 42:541 is liable to the
5	affected employee in the amount of the difference between the amount that the
6	employee was paid and the amount the employer was statutorily obligated to pay
7	pursuant to R.S. 42:541 plus reasonable attorney fees and court costs associated with
8	the civil action.
9	§544. Limitation of action
10	A civil action filed to recover wages for a violation of this Chapter shall be
11	commenced within three years from the date that an employee becomes aware that
12	the employer is in violation of this Chapter.
13	§545. Definition
14	For purpose of this Chapter, "state employee" means a person who is
15	employed by an agency or instrumentality of the state of Louisiana, including the
16	executive, legislative, and judicial branches of state government.

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Abstract: Establishes a minimum wage of \$9.00 per hour for state employees.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that no employee of any agency or instrumentality of the state shall be paid at a rate of less than \$9.00 per hour. Provides that if federal or state law requires a minimum rate of pay for a state employee that is higher than the rate required by <u>proposed</u> law, the higher rate shall apply to the employee.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that in addition to any other remedy provided by law, an employee shall have a civil right of action for damages against an employer for a violation of <u>proposed</u> <u>law</u>. Further provides that an employer that violates <u>proposed law</u> shall be liable in the amount of the difference between the amount that the employee was paid and the amount the employer was statutorily obligated to pay plus reasonable attorney fees and court costs. <u>Proposed law</u> requires that an action pursuant to <u>proposed law</u> be commenced within three years from the date that an employee becomes aware that the employer is in violation of proposed law.
