Abstract: Makes changes to the examination and licensing requirements for persons seeking a license from the La. Cosmetology Board (board).

<u>Present law</u> allows a person with an out-of-state license, in a field regulated by the board, to receive a license if they pass a test provided by the board and pay the required fees.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> in part, but removes the examination requirement to allow for license portability.

<u>Present law</u> requires a person applying for a license from the board to satisfy various requirements prior to being issued a license. As part of the requirements in <u>present law</u>, the applicant is required to take and pass a practical examination.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the practical examination from the list of requirements and retains the remainder of the qualifications.

<u>Present law</u> allows an applicant to take an examination for licensure upon completion of all educational course work.

<u>Proposed law</u> still allows an applicant to take an examination after completion of the coursework, but also allows an applicant to take an examination upon completion of 75% of the coursework.
