Abstract: Provides relative to payment for state charges.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the state, through any department, agency, board, commission, or other state entity, may accept payment of any obligation that the state entity is authorized to collect, including but not limited to taxes, fees, charges, licenses, service fees or charges, fines, penalties, interest, sanctions, stamps, surcharges, assessments, obligations, and any other similar charges or obligations, by credit cards, debit cards, and any other forms of electronic payments approved by the treasurer as provided in <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and specifies that a state entity may accept payment of any obligation due to the state entity for which it is authorized to collect.
