1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, delete "R.S. 46:1844(O)(3)" and insert "R.S. 46:1844(N)(5)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, delete lines 8 though 18 and on page 2 delete lines 1 through 11 and insert the  
5 following:

6 "Section 1. R.S. 46:1844(N)(5) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §1844. Basic rights for victim and witness

8 N. Duties of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections. (1) In cases  
9 where the sentence is the death penalty, the victim's family shall have the right to be  
10 notified by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections of the time, date, and  
11 place of the execution, and a minimum of two representatives of the victim's family  
12 shall have the right to be present.

14 (5) When an inmate who has been convicted of a crime of violence as defined  
15 in R.S. 14:2(B) or a sex offense as defined in R.S. 15:541 is eligible for release  
16 pursuant to R.S. 15:571.3, the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall  
17 notify the victim or the victim's family, all persons who have filed a victim  
18 registration and notification form, the appropriate law enforcement agency, and the  
19 appropriate district attorney no later than sixty days prior to the inmate's release."
