ROADS/HIGHWAYS. Designates a portion of LA 16 in St. Helena Parish as the "Trooper George Baker Memorial Highway". (8/1/22)

1 AN ACT

2 To provide relative to state highways; to designate a portion of La Highway 16 in St. Helena
3 Parish as the "Trooper George Baker Memorial Highway"; to provide for restrictions
4 on costs of materials to the department; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 **Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the**
7 **portion of Louisiana Highway 16 in St. Helena Parish from the Tangipahoa Parish line**
8 **to the Livingston Parish line, is hereby designated as the "Trooper George Baker**
9 **Memorial Highway" provided local or private monies are received by the department**
10 **equal to the department's actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and**
11 **installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of five hundred fifty dollars per sign.**

12 **Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby**
13 **directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs of this designation.**
