## CONDOLENCES: Expresses condolences on the death of Huey Long Hebert

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To express the condolences of the House of Representatives upon the death of Huey Long
3	Hebert.
4	WHEREAS, it is with immense sadness and profound regret that the House of
5	Representatives has learned of the death, on March 14, 2022, of Huey Long Hebert; and
6	WHEREAS, Huey was born to Frank James and Georgia Hearn Hebert on
7	January 29, 1931, in LeCompte, Louisiana; he graduated from Forest Hill High School in
8	1948 and, shortly after, enlisted to serve in the United States Air Force; and
9	WHEREAS, Mr. Hebert received his military training at Scott Air Force Base in
10	St. Clair County, Illinois; he specialized in radio technology on fighter jets, specifically the
11	Lockheed F-80 Shooting Star, before being deployed to Okinawa, Japan; and
12	WHEREAS, after returning from Okinawa in 1951, Mr. Hebert was transferred to
13	MacDill Air Force Base in Tampa, Florida; while in Tampa he crashed a New Year's Eve
14	party and met the love of his life and the woman with whom he would spend the rest of his
15	life, Caryl Francis Grant; and
16	WHEREAS, after completing his military service, Huey used the skills he acquired
17	during his Air Force training to start a career in the television and electronics business; he
18	eventually opened his own business, Hebert's TV; and
19	WHEREAS, Huey was committed to his Southern Baptist faith; he routinely read his
20	Bible and raised his children to love and respect God; he was immensely proud of his faith
21	and held his family to the same standard; and

1	WHEREAS, Huey Long Hebert leaves to cherish his memory his loving wife of
2	sixty-nine years, Caryl Francis Grant Hebert; his sons, Frank Hebert, and his wife Faye, John
3	Hebert, and his wife Kitty, and Blaine Hebert, and his wife Kirsten; daughter, Grace Hebert
4	Broussard, and her husband Byron; daughter-in-law, Caren Hebert; twenty-two
5	grandchildren; and forty-four great-grandchildren; he will be deeply missed but certainly
6	never forgotten.
7	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
8	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby express heartfelt condolences on the death of Huey
9	Long Hebert; does hereby posthumously recognize Mr. Hebert for his military service and
