## 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 2, delete lines 15 through 18 in their entirety and insert the following:
- "(1) The permanent injunction or protective order includes a finding that the person subject to the permanent injunction or protective order represents a credible threat to the physical safety of a family member, household member, or dating partner, and either:
  - (a) The finding was made by clear and convincing evidence.
  - (b) The permanent injunction or protective order was issued pursuant to Code of Criminal Procedure Articles 30, 320, or 871.1."

## 10 AMENDMENT NO. 2

- On page 2, delete lines 20 through 23 and insert the following:
- 12 "(3) The permanent injunction or protective order was issued under any of the following circumstances:
- 14 (a) Pursuant to Code of Criminal Procedure Articles 30, 320, or 871.1.
- 15 (b) After a consent agreement between the parties.
- (c) After reasonable notice and opportunity to be heard was given to the
- person against whom the order was sought sufficient to protect that person's right to
- due process.
