
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2022 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to Original House Bill No. 464 by Representative Seabaugh

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, delete lines 15 through 18 in their entirety and insert the following:

3 "(1) The permanent injunction or protective order includes a finding that the
4 person subject to the permanent injunction or protective order represents a credible
5 threat to the physical safety of a family member, household member, or dating
6 partner, and either:

7 (a) The finding was made by clear and convincing evidence.

8 (b) The permanent injunction or protective order was issued pursuant to
9 Code of Criminal Procedure Articles 30, 320, or 871.1."

10 AMENDMENT NO. 2

11 On page 2, delete lines 20 through 23 and insert the following:

12 "(3) The permanent injunction or protective order was issued under any of
13 the following circumstances:

14 (a) Pursuant to Code of Criminal Procedure Articles 30, 320, or 871.1.

15 (b) After a consent agreement between the parties.

16 (c) After reasonable notice and opportunity to be heard was given to the
17 person against whom the order was sought sufficient to protect that person's right to
18 due process.
