- 2 On page 1, line 7, after "definitions;" insert "to provide for exceptions; to provide for effectiveness;"

- 7 On page 1, line 15, change "services" to "physical therapy services"
- 8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 2, at the end of line 28, delete the period "." and insert a semicolon ":" and 10 "however, a health coverage plan may restrict physical therapy services via telehealth when

- 11 the services are being provided solely by telephone."
- 12 AMENDMENT NO. 5
- 13 On page 3, at the end of line 2, delete the period "." and insert a semicolon ";" and "however,
- 14 <u>a health coverage plan may require the provider to demonstrate that the technology used to</u>
- 15 provide telehealth services is both safe and secure."
- 16 AMENDMENT NO. 6
- 17 On page 3, at the end of line 4, delete the period "." and insert a semicolon ":" and "however,
- 18 this Paragraph does not prohibit a health coverage plan from providing additional
- 19 reimbursement incentives to providers with an enhanced certification, training, or
- 20 <u>accreditation.</u>"
- 21 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 7</u>
- 22 On page 3, after line 18, add the following:
- 23 "Section 2. This Act shall apply to any new health coverage plan issued on and after
- January 1, 2023. Any health coverage plan in effect prior to January 1, 2023, shall convert
 to conform to the provisions of this Act on or before the renewal date, but no later than
- 26 January 1, 2024."
