2 On page 1, at the end of line 4, insert "to provide for effectiveness;"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 24 On page 1, line 19, after "plans," and before "short-term" delete "and"5 AMENDMENT NO. 36 On page 1, line 20, after "months" and before the period ":" insert a comma "," and "and

16 On page 2, between lines 7 and 8, insert the following:

17 "(2) On January first of each year, the limit on the amount that an insured is
18 required to pay for a thirty-day supply of a covered prescription of insulin as
19 provided for in this Subsection shall increase by a percentage equal to the percentage
20 change from the preceding year in the prescription drug component of the Consumer
21 Price Index of the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics."22 AMENDMENT NO. 823 On page 2, line 9, after "formulary" and before the period ":" insert "that complies with the
24 provisions of this Section"25 AMENDMENT NO. 9

26 On page 2, after line 9, add the following:

27 "Section 2. This Act shall apply to any new health coverage plan issued on and after
28 January 1, 2023. Any health coverage plan in effect prior to January 1, 2023, shall convert
29 to conform to the provisions of this Act on or before the renewal date, but no later than
30 January 1, 2024."
