- 4 "If a person was incarcerated or on probation or parole for a felony offense after a
- 5 <u>conviction rendered by a verdict from a non-unanimous jury, the person may qualify</u>
- 6 to serve as a juror immediately upon completion of any sentence, and the person
- 5 shall not be required to wait the five-year period as provided by Subsubparagraph
- 8 (5)(a) of this Paragraph before serving on a jury."
