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Provides for the funding of certain projects from the Construction Subfund. (7/1/22)

Present law provides for the funding of certain listed or described transportation projects from the Construction Subfund of the Transportation Trust Fund.

Proposed law provides that the projects listed or described in **present law** shall be funded, constructed, built or worked on even if the project is not a state-owned road or bridge, or other state project, notwithstanding any law or regulation to the contrary. **Proposed law** makes a technical change to a project name. **Proposed law** clarifies application of La. Const. Article VII, Section 27(B)(2) to specific projects to be funded with monies deposited into the subfund.

Proposed law is effective July 1, 2022.
