HOUSE BILL NO. 510

TEACHERS: Provides relative to the effectiveness of additional teacher training requirements

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:420, relative to public school teachers; to provide relative to the
3 effectiveness of requirements for training of professional teachers; and to provide for
4 related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 17:420 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §420. Required teacher training

8 No requirement that increases the uncompensated training burden on
9 professional teachers shall become effective. A requirement for additional teacher
10 training shall become effective only if provision is made for teachers to receive the
11 training at a time when they are being compensated and not participating in local
12 professional development activities or the burden of the requirement is offset by the
13 elimination of another training requirement completion of which requires at least the
14 same amount of time as the additional requirement.

HB 510 Engrossed

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Proposed law provides that a requirement for additional teacher training shall become effective only if provision is made for teachers to receive the training at a time when they are being compensated and not participating in local professional development activities or the burden of the requirement is offset by the elimination of another training requirement completion of which requires at least the same amount of time as the additional requirement.

(Adds R.S. 17:420)

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Education to the original bill:

1. Relative to provisions that must be made for a new training requirement to become effective, provide that the training is received at a time when a teacher is not only compensated but also not participating in local professional development activities.
