1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 17 through 19 and on page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert the
3 following:

4 "B. A payor is not liable for having made payment in good faith reliance on
5 the validity of a beneficiary designation affecting any pension, profit-sharing,
6 retirement, or similar benefit plan before the payor has received written notice of the
7 divorce, judgment, or property-settlement agreement, and has had a reasonable time
8 within which to act."

9 AMENDMENT NO. 2

10 On page 3, delete lines 5 through 8 and insert the following:

11 "B. A payor is not liable for having made payment in good faith reliance on
12 the validity of a beneficiary designation affecting any insurance policy or annuity
13 before the payor has received written notice of the divorce, judgment, or
14 property-settlement agreement, and has had a reasonable time within which to act."
