Autonomous vehicle equipment requirements 7 A motor vehicle with autonomous technology that is designed to be 8 operated exclusively by an automated driving system for all trips shall not be 9 subject to motor vehicle equipment laws or equipment regulations of this state 10 that relate to or support motor vehicle operation by a human driver and are not 11 relevant for an automated driving system.
