2 On page 1, line 3, change "an effective date;" to "effectiveness;"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

- 4 On page 2, line 6, after "Section 2." delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 7
- 5 through 10 and insert the following:
- "The provisions of this Act shall become effective on January 1, 2023, but shall be implemented only after the legislature appropriates sufficient funds to the Department of State to cover the cost of postage paid return envelopes for ballots. For purposes of this Section, "sufficient funds" shall mean funds in an amount no less than the amount of recurring expenditures for Fiscal Year 2024 estimated in the fiscal note produced by the legislative fiscal
- office for this Act."
