On page 2, line 2, after "<u>contrary</u>," delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 3 through
5 in their entirety and insert the following:

12 "an inmate housed at a state correctional facility shall not be required to make a 13 copayment of an amount greater than two dollars upon receiving medical or dental 14 treatment. An inmate who has two hundred dollars or less in a drawing account shall 15 not be required to make a copayment of any amount upon receiving medical or 16 dental treatment. 17 (b) Notwithstanding Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph, an inmate housed 18 at a state correctional facility shall not be charged for prescriptions written and 19 dispensed, including orders for prosthetics. *" 20
