On page 1, line 11, after "within" delete the remainder of the line, delete line 12 in its entirety, and insert in lieu thereof the following:

5 "ten business days after the state registrar has received the applicant's request for the death certificate. The state registrar's provision of the death certificate, to the 6 7 applicant, shall be deemed timely when it has been mailed via the United States 8 Postal Service, or with a commercial mail service, with a timely commercial mail 9 meter stamp or commercial mail service certificate that is within the ten-business-10 day period. Any death certificate provided to an applicant outside of the ten business days that is unable to be meter-stamped for United States Postal Service mail 11 delivery or certified for commercial mail service delivery during the ten-business-12 13 day period due to events outside of the state registrar's control, shall be considered 14 timely provided."
