Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Original House Bill No. 505 by Representative Jefferson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, at the end of line 8, insert the following:

3 "The term shall not include any individual employed by a fire department of any
4 municipality, parish, or fire protection district or any volunteer firefighter of the state
5 of Louisiana."

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 2, delete line 12 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

8 "or license renewal, or certification of emergency medical"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 3

10 On page 2, delete lines 23 through 25 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

11 "(5) Ambulance operator certification \$10.00"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 3, line 8, after "operator certification" insert a period "." and delete the remainder
14 of the line

15 AMENDMENT NO. 5

16 On page 3, delete lines 10 and 11 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

17 "(11) Issue a certification to any duly qualified applicant for certification as
18 an ambulance operator."

19 AMENDMENT NO. 6

20 On page 4, at the beginning of line 21, delete "Louisiana"

21 AMENDMENT NO. 7

22 On page 4, delete lines 24 through 27 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

23 "C. An ambulance operator certification shall expire one year after it is
24 issued and shall not be renewable."
