1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, change "grant" to "reimbursement"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, delete lines 14 through 17 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

5 "B. The program administrator, through the Department of Economic  
6 Development, shall award a reimbursement to an applicant who purchases an eligible  
7 energy storage system and otherwise satisfies the provisions of this Chapter."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 2, delete line 2 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

10 "be dedicated to reimbursements for lower and middle income residential  
11 applicants."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 2, line 7, change "grant certificates" to "reimbursement"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 5

15 On page 2, delete line 8 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

16 "A. Except as provided for in Paragraph (4) of this Subsection, the amount  
17 of a reimbursement awarded pursuant to this Chapter shall be calculated as the  
18 lowest amount as determined by application of the following parameters:"

21 "(4) One hundred thousand dollars for an energy storage system, with a  
22 minimum system storage size of three hundred kilowatt-hours, installed on a  
23 commercial or nonprofit property, if the property on which the system was installed  
24 is utilized for a resiliency and response center after a disaster. When applicable, the  
25 program administrator shall calculate the reimbursement amount in accordance with  
26 this Paragraph, without consideration of any lower amount calculated pursuant to this  
27 Subsection."
