Provides relative to federal election guidance and funding

Proposed Law requires an election official to notify the Governor, the Speaker of the House, and the President of the Senate within five (5) days if they receive a federal directive or guidance pertaining to elections. Proposed law prohibits an election official from implementing federal directives or guidance unless it is explicitly required by law or (1) the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs and the Senate Committee on Governmental Affairs approves the implementation, or (2) neither committee prohibits the implementation within 30 days of the request from the election official to implement the directive or guidance. If either committee votes to prohibit the implementation within 30 days, the election official shall not implement such directive or guidance. Proposed law prohibits an election official from accepting or dispersing any new federal election funds unless the acceptance and dispersal is explicitly required by law or (1) the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget (JLCB) votes to approve the acceptance and dispersal of the funds, or (2) JLCB does not disapprove of the acceptance and distribution of the funds within 30 days of the request from the election official to accept and disperse the funds. If JLCB votes to disapprove the acceptance and dispersal of funds within 30 days, the election official shall not accept such funds.
