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**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

2022 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs  
to Original House Bill No. 960 by Representative Wilford Carter

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1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, line 4, after "perimeter:" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 5 in its  
3 entirety and insert "Commencing at the point where Kayouche Coolie intersects with English  
4 Bayou thence westward along the southern banks of the English Bayou until the English  
5 Bayou intersects with the Calcasieu River westward along the southern banks of Calcasieu  
6 River to a point on Calcasieu River southern banks where if Kirkman were extended  
7 northward it would intersect with Calcasieu River thence southward along Kirkman Street  
8 to I-210 bypass thence east along I-210 to a point where I-210 intersects with Kayouche  
9 Coolie thence north following Kayouche Coolie to the point of commencement."

10 AMENDMENT NO. 2

11 On page 2, line 18, after "approval of the" delete the remainder of the line and insert "Lake  
12 Charles City Council."

13 AMENDMENT NO. 3

14 On page 2, line 19, after "The" and before "shall appoint" delete "governing authority of the  
15 city of Lake Charles" and insert "Lake Charles City Council"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 4

17 On page 2, line 22, after "appoint" delete "two" and on line 23, delete "members." and insert  
18 "one member."

19 AMENDMENT NO. 5

20 On page 3, line 2, after "Louisiana Black Chamber of Commerce" and before "shall" insert  
21 a comma "," and "the Lake Charles Branch,"

22 AMENDMENT NO. 6

23 On page 3, between lines 3 and 4, insert the following:

24 "(g) The members of the governing authority of Calcasieu Parish who represent  
25 District Nos. 2, 3, 4, and 9 shall jointly appoint one member upon approval of three  
26 of the four members."

27 AMENDMENT NO. 7

28 On page 10, between lines 12 and 13, insert the following:

29 "M.(1) In addition to the authority provided to the district by this Section,  
30 the district may levy and collect a sales and use tax within the boundaries of the  
31 district not to exceed one percent. The purpose and rate of the tax shall be as  
32 provided by duly adopted resolution of the board.

33 (2) The tax shall be levied upon the sale at retail, the use, the lease or rental,  
34 the consumption, the distribution, and storage for use or consumption of tangible  
35 personal property, and upon the sales of services within the boundaries of the district,  
36 all as defined in R.S. 47:301 et seq.

- 1           (3) Except where inapplicable, the procedure established by R.S. 47:301 et
- 2 seq. shall be followed in the imposition, collection, and enforcement of the tax, and
- 3 procedural details necessary to supplement those Sections and to make them
- 4 applicable to the tax authorized in this Subsection shall be fixed in the resolution
- 5 imposing the tax.
- 6           (4) The tax shall be imposed and collected uniformly throughout the
- 7 jurisdiction of the district.
- 8           (5) The tax levied pursuant to this Subsection shall be in addition to all other
- 9 taxes other political subdivisions within the district are authorized to levy and
- 10 collect."

11 AMENDMENT NO. 8

12 On page 10, at the beginning of line 13 change "M." to "N."

13 AMENDMENT NO. 9

14 On page 10, at the beginning of line 18, change "N." to "O."
