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Requires instruction relative to cardiac health in high school

Proposed law requires the Department of Education (LDE) to develop a sudden cardiac arrest education program. Requires each public school nurse, coach, athletic trainer, and athletic director, whether employed or serving as a volunteer, to complete such program. Authorizes the LDE to use materials and resources created and offered free of charge by nonprofit organizations with missions related to cardiac health and for the LDE to make the program available on its website free of charge.
