BUDGETARY CONTROLS: Restricts spending of state general fund revenue-direct to 98% of the official forecast

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 39:34(F) and 54(E), relative to the expenditure of state funds; to limit
3	recommended appropriations from state general fund revenue-direct in the executive
4	budget; to limit appropriations from state general fund revenue-direct by the
5	legislature; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. $39:34(F)$ and $54(E)$ are hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§34. Executive budget

10	F. For Fiscal Year 2023-2024 and for each fiscal year thereafter, the
11	executive budget recommendations for appropriations from state general fund
12	revenue-direct shall not exceed ninety-eight percent of the official forecast of the
13	Revenue Estimating Conference for state general fund revenue-direct. For purposes
14	of this Section, "state general fund revenue-direct" means total taxes, licenses, and
15	fees and any additional funds incorporated into the forecast less dedications as
16	recognized by the Revenue Estimating Conference.

1	E. For Fiscal Year 2023-2024 and for each fiscal year thereafter,
2	appropriations by the legislature from state general fund revenue-direct shall not
3	exceed ninety-eight percent of the official forecast of the Revenue Estimating
4	Conference for state general fund revenue-direct in effect at the time the
5	appropriations are made. For purposes of this Section, "state general fund revenue-
6	direct" means total taxes, licenses, and fees and any additional funds incorporated
7	into the forecast less dedications as recognized by the Revenue Estimating
8	Conference.

Abstract: Limits appropriations from state general fund revenue-direct to 98% of the official forecast.

<u>Present law</u> requires that recommendations for appropriations in the executive budget for the ensuing fiscal year from the state general fund and dedicated funds not exceed the official forecast of the Revenue Estimating Conference (REC).

<u>Proposed law retains present law</u> and additionally requires that, beginning with the executive budget for FY 2023-2024, recommendations for appropriations from state general fund revenue-direct not exceed 98% of the official REC forecast for state general fund revenue-direct.

<u>Present law</u> requires that appropriations by the legislature from the state general fund and dedicated funds not exceed the official forecast in effect at the time the appropriations are made.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and additionally requires that, beginning with FY 2023-2024, appropriations from state general fund revenue-direct not exceed 98% of the official REC forecast for state general fund revenue-direct.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "state general fund revenue-direct" as total taxes, licenses, and fees and any additional funds incorporated into the forecast less dedications as recognized by the REC.
