AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, delete lines 2 through 6 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"To enact R.S. 37:3611 and 3612, relative to occupational licensing; to provide definitions;
to require certain boards to publish information relative to occupational licensing on
their website; to require an annual update; and to provide for related matters."

"Section 1. R.S. 37:3611 and 3612 are hereby enacted to read as follows:"

On page 1, delete lines 17 through 20 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"§3612. Licensing data to be published
A. A professional or occupational licensing board in this state shall publish
on its website all of the following:
(1) The total number of license renewals issued by the board statewide and
by parish of residency.
(2) The total number of new licenses issued by the board statewide and by
parish of residency.
(3) The total number of applications for license renewal that were denied by
the board statewide and by parish of residency.
(4) The total number of requests for a new license that were denied by the
board statewide and by parish of residency.
B. A professional or occupational licensing board in this state shall update
annually the information published pursuant to Subsection A of this Section.
Section 2. The information required by R.S. 37:3612 as enacted by Section 1 of this
Act shall be published annually beginning on February 15, 2023."
